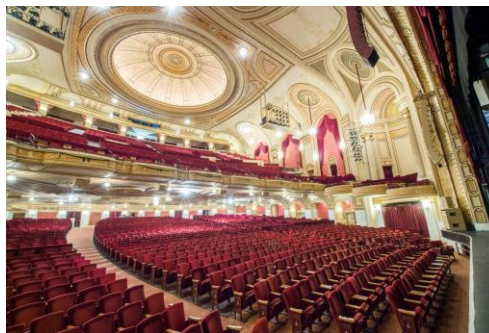

POSITION ASSIGNMENTS

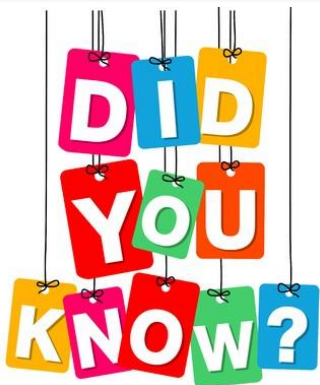
The Volunteer Office tries to vary position assignments for all volunteers for each performance.

PLAYHOUSE SQUARE VOLUNTEERS

Playhouse Square maintains a volunteer base of between 1800 – 1900 volunteers. Each year, we recruit 300 – 400 new volunteers and lose approximately the same number of volunteers to retirement, family or work commitments, health issues, moving out of the area, or any other reason.
