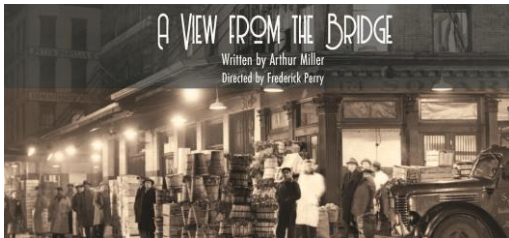
Please access the US Bank garage via the Prospect entrance on Sunday. The sidewalk and crosswalk on the west (US Bank) side of the road will remain open.

A View From The Bridge

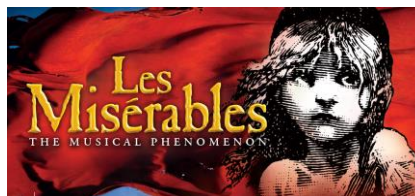
