A few notes below to answer questions that have arisen:

I couldn't make it to the fitting

Check your email later this week! We will be sending out a survey where you can submit your size. Now that we have sizes for most people, we will be estimating the remaining ones we need to purchase to accommodate those who did not make it to the fittings and those who will need to swap sizes.

Why blazers?

For many years, people have been frustrated with the lack of uniformity in our RedCoat uniforms and many suggested that we require everyone to purchase the same blazer. The generous donation from the Reinberger Foundation allows us to increase the professionalism of our volunteer program, while eliminating any barriers that would prohibit people from volunteering their time.

Do I get to take the blazer home?

The blazers will be given on semi-permanent loan to you. They will be yours to take home, we only ask that when you retire from volunteering that you return them to us to pass on to another volunteer.

Petite Sizing

The women's blazers currently come in two lengths. Short/Regular and Regular/Tall. At the fittings, we spoke with several of you who felt that the Short/Regular didn't work for those with shorter arms. We are currently working with the provider about possible options to address this issue.

We've added a few new posts to our Facebook page that I wanted to update you all on. Below you will find our new Community Guidelines. Additionally, I've included instructions on how to report a post or comment.

Community Guidelines

1. Be kind. Don't say anything online that you wouldn't say directly to someone. Remember that your kind or joking tone is often lost over a written message.
2. No hate speech or bullying. This is not a space for political or social arguments, nor for name-calling or personal attacks. We will remove anything we find to be inappropriate or offensive.
3. Respect the privacy of others. Do not post anyone's personal information, things you have been told in confidence, pictures, or private messages.

How to Report a Facebook Post

Group Administrators are not always notified when content is added to the group. If a post or comment is offensive or violates our community guidelines you can "flag" the post so the Group Admin will be notified to review it.

- Reporting a Post – click the down arrow in the top, right corner of the post and click on "Report Post to Group Admins".
- Reporting a Comment – hover your mouse over a comment and three dots will appear on the right-hand side. Click on the three dots and then on, "Give Feedback or Report this Comment".
