### *New Blazer Update!*

Thank you, once again to all who came to the blazer fittings or who completed the online survey!

We have placed our order and anxiously anticipate our new uniforms for next season!

**Timing** - blazers are expected to arrive in mid-September. We will send out information in late summer about how distribution will work

**Sizing** - we have recorded most volunteer's sizes and are buying above what we need in each size. There will be options for swapping sizes.

**Old Blazers** - Once we receive the new blazers we will no longer be wearing other blazers as our new ones will promote uniformity across all volunteers!

We are so excited for the next steps. Look in future newsletters for information about how to pick yours up in September!

### *Check Back Dates*

Several months ago we switched to using "Check Back" dates on performances that are full. This system allows us to add people to a performance once others have cancelled.

#### Procedure

- Once a show has reached maximum capacity for volunteers we write on the schedule, "check back" and a date.
- When a check back date is listed, you may not request to be a volunteer until that date.
- If you show up at a performance with a check back date and have not received permission by the volunteer office to be there you may be turned away and will not be given hours for your time

### *Parking Reminder*



As a reminder – In the US Bank garage, all RedCoats should be parking starting at 7 and then working their way down to lower floors.
