# Hamilton Information

Hello RedCoats! In this newsletter we have compiled all of the Hamilton information that we have at this time. Please read it carefully as there are many important details for you to know!

# How Do I Buy Tickets?

- Hamilton tickets will go on sale on Friday, April 13th at 9:00am
- They will be available online, in person, and over the phone •
  - Online: There is an online queue beginning before 9am. Everyone 0 who enters playhousesquare.org/hamilton before 9am will be assigned a number at random to queue them for tickets. There is no advantage to being earlier. You will be let into the ticket buying site in order of your random queue number until tickets are no longer available
  - Phone: Beginning at 9am you can call either 216.241.6000 or 0 866.546.1353 to enter the queue to buy tickets. You may have to keep trying back to get through until you are entered into the phone queue.
  - In Person: Tickets will go on sale in the KeyBank State Ticket Office 0 Lobby beginning at 9am. We expect a great deal of people coming in this way.
- DO NOT CALL THE VOLUNTEER OFFICE WITH TICKET QUESTIONS. We do not have access to any ticket buying information and will likely not be in our office as we will be helping in the Ticket Office Lobby.
- There are no reserved tickets for any groups (RedCoats, group sales, season ticket holders etc.) so everyone must go through the same public sale. We recommend that you do not purchase tickets for a day you may be scheduled as we will not be able to move your volunteer time to accommodate (e.g. if you are a TU E volunteer, do not buy tickets on a Tuesday).
- If you do not get tickets: •
  - There will be 37 \$10 lottery tickets available for each performance. Look for further details in the future.
  - Please sign up at playhousesquare.org/hamilton for further news. 0
- Buy directly from Playhouse Square!!! Please encourage your friends to not buy from third party sellers. There are already sites with tickets for sale at our theaters but they may not be legitimate tickets. We will not be able to accommodate anyone who buys fake tickets.

# Scheduled Volunteering

- We expect each evening and weekend team will be scheduled twice
- Weekday Matinee Teams, MO E Teams, and STARS will be given an opportunity to be scheduled for Hamilton once
- You must be an active volunteer in good standing to work Hamilton
- The Hamilton schedule will be released in its entirety on Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>.
  Following that, there are set windows of time for requested changes. We will give instructions in greater detail as these times get closer. Any changes sent outside of the appropriate window will not be honored.
  - Weekday Matinee Teams, MO E Teams, and STARS
    - Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>
  - Swap and Extra Requests
    - Wednesday, June 13<sup>th</sup> Friday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>
  - You will be emailed the week of July 2<sup>nd</sup> confirming all of the days you are scheduled to work Hamilton (both your scheduled days and extras)

### Changes to Schedule

- Cancellations If you do not want to work Hamilton you may cancel with no penalty to your attendance
- Extras there will be limited opportunities for extras. Each volunteer can put in one request to extra with their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice of performances. <u>You must</u> <u>give us your two choices</u>. Messages stating that you can work any performance will not be honored.
  - These will be based first on availability (who has requested that performance and how many are needed), and then on attendance percentage, Head Usher status, and hours or years worked
  - We will be putting a list on our website: <u>http://www.playhousesquare.org/volunteer-home</u> with your ID number, attendance percentage, and hours worked so you can check it prior to signing up. Please note – if you are new your percentage may be listed as 0% if you haven't been here long enough for it to calculate. This will be remedied as we get closer.
- Swapping If you cannot work <u>either</u> of your scheduled performances you may <u>swap both</u> of them for <u>one</u> alternative performance. If you cannot make one performance, you will be removed from the list and it will not count against your attendance percentage but cannot be made up.
- There will be no opportunities to make up missed performances.

### **Other Questions**

- The run time is 2 hours and 45 minutes with intermission
- There will be no seats available at any performance
- We will be checking photo IDs upon entrance. You must have your photo ID and be on the list to be admitted to work. If you are not on the list you will be turned away
- You may not bring anyone who is not assigned with you to performances
- We do not have any way to facilitate you buying tickets
- We will have extra support from the Ticket Office to handle scanning and ticketing issues as well as added Security to address any concerns
- We will not be bringing on new RedCoats during or leading up to Hamilton
- Parking will remain the same please park in the US Bank Garage for all Hamilton performances on the top two levels, or as otherwise specified by the attendant
- Please direct all questions from friends and family members to the PHS website. We would prefer that you not respond to social media requests for information.


