#### Qualifications:

- Able to work upstairs and downstairs; good knowledge of all the
- Dependable, self-motivated, team player, excellent communication and problem solving skills
- Able to remain for the entire performance

#### Responsibilities:

- Check in 15 minutes before regular volunteers for the pre-show Head Usher briefing
- Follow designated policies and procedures as specified by the House
- Be vigilant of potential safety issues
- Supervise pre-show and end of performance volunteer duties
- Team leader for volunteers in assigned area
- Ensure all equipment is returned to designated areas
