Cancelling Shows

PLEASE cancel shows in advance if at all possible. I will give an example of a problem we are seeing chronically. A couple weekends ago we had Trailer Park Boys and Thom Yorke. When I left on Friday evening, we had enough RedCoats scheduled for both shows.

In the next 24 hours we had both of those shows drop by 20+ volunteers. That means 40+ people cancelled within 24 hours of the show. We understand that due to sickness, car trouble etc. that sometimes last minute cancels are unavoidable. However, if at all possible please cancel in advance to give us the chance to make changes so our fellow RedCoats and FOH staff are not left without help.

Thoto Policies for RedCoats
