Dear RedCoats,

As we approach the beginning of our 2017 / 2018 season, we are actively recruiting volunteers with a positive attitude and good leadership skills to join our Head Usher team.

### Qualifications:

- Minimum one year experience as a volunteer
- 90% attendance or better
- Able to work upstairs and downstairs; good knowledge of all the theaters
- Dependable, self-motivated, team player, excellent communication and problem solving skills
- Able to remain for the entire performance

### Responsibilities:

- Check in 15 minutes before regular volunteers for the pre-show Head Usher briefing
- Follow designated policies and procedures as specified by the House Manager
- Be vigilant of potential safety issues
- Supervise pre-show and end of performance volunteer duties
- Team leader for volunteers in assigned area
- Ensure all equipment is returned to designated areas

It is important to remember that Head Usher duties still include seating and assisting guests.
