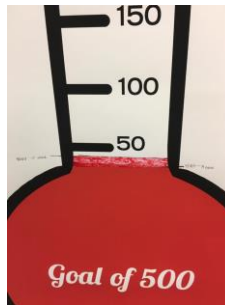

### *Recruitment Report*

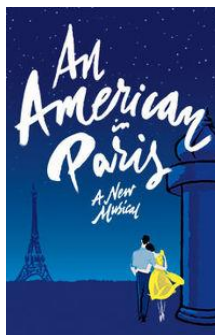
