Congratulations to all of you on the successful run of Hello, Dolly! Thank you to each of you for the work you did on this show. It was a great kickoff to our 2018-19 season and we are looking forward to the rest of the year!

We will be continuing to hand out pins during our final week of Les Mis, the second show in the series, and then will take a break until Miss Saigon comes at the end of January. A few reminders as we head into the rest of the season:

Cancelling Shows

We understand that sometimes last-minute cancellations are unavoidable when sickness or unexpected commitments arrive, however, if you are able to cancel in advance it is greatly appreciated! The last few weeks we have had several shows with 10-20 cancelations within 24 hours, making it difficult for us to find replacements. Canceling early gives us the chance to put the call out for extras and avoid low staffing at performances.

Leaving Early

When you come as a volunteer, please commit to staying through the whole performance. While it may seem that you are not as needed after intermission, it is important that we have a full staff of RedCoats here in case we need to evacuate the theaters. We understand there are occasional times when commitments arrive that require you to leave early. When this happens, please let the Head Usher or House Manager know when you sign in that you will be leaving early, so they can ensure they have enough volunteers to cover evacuation routes.

Theater Bars

As a reminder, please do not ask the bartenders for cups of water, soda etc when you are volunteering. These items are provided in the Volunteer Room for you so that they are accessible. The bartenders are not allowed to give out items to the volunteers, so please be respectful as asking could put them in a difficult situation with their supervisor.

Thank you all for your help! We are looking forward to our final performances of Les Mis and heading into our holiday shows in the coming weeks!
