


Just how busy you ask? The holiday season began on November 25th with the first Christmas Carol matinee. From November 25 – December 28, Playhouse Square hosted 120 performances and events and over 102,470 guests came through our doors!

THE HOUSE IS OPEN!

"The House" refers to the audience seating area or the audience itself. "House open in theater" means the doors to the theater are opened, and the audience is allowed to enter and find their seats before a performance. This signals Redcoats for the start of pre-show activities.

When the House Manager announces that the "house is open", we open all doors and prepare to assist our guests in finding their seats... with a smile, of course!



SEATS FOR VOLUNTEERS

Having seats for volunteers at a performance is never guaranteed.

The House Managers do their best to arrange seating for ushers. If you are assigned to a performance, the House Manager will let everyone know during the pre-show meeting if seats are available.

The House Manager or the Head Usher for your area will release you once the holds are over and you can take the appropriate seats at that time. Please do not take a seat until you are released and specifically approved for seating areas by the House Manager or Head Usher.
