CELL PHONES



OBSERVATION: "The last two shows I worked, RedCoats had phones ringing multiple times during the performances. Everyone forgets, but after the first time, fix it. It's embarrassing to be sitting in a clump of ushers when one's phone keeps ringing and they do not know how to stop it."

SOLUTION: Put your phone on vibrate before entering the theatre. If you are not sure how to do that, ask for help.

APPROACHABILITY

OBSERVATION: "It is very hard for me when my colleagues use the intermission as a personal social hour and congregate in conversation. While we may not be needed by a guest, we certainly look unapproachable and unavailable when grouped in little conclaves of red."

SOLUTION: There are several ways to be more approachable / available:

- 1. Smile
- 2. Make eye contact with guests
- 3. Look up!
- 4. Ignore your phone
- 5. Keep your face and body visible

Remember, guests may feel uncomfortable approaching a group – especially if that group is seemingly engaged in conversation.
