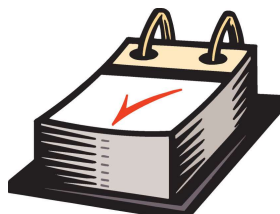

## UNIFORM CARE

We have received many questions on the proper method to care for the RedCoat blazers.

The blazers should be dry-cleaned. Spot-cleaning the collar and cuffs is recommended.

Vests for the Stars Program participants can be washed in cold water on a delicate cycle.

The Volunteer Department has a small supply of buttons for both the sleeves and the front of the blazers. If you are missing a button, please email the office and a button will be sent to your next assignment. Nylon thread or fishing line work best for reattaching buttons. Metal buttons tend to “saw through” regular thread.

Replacement flashlights and ties are available for purchase for \$5 each.
