## Interacting with Differentially Abled Guests

**Interacting with People with Disabilities:** When you interact with people with disabilities, talk directly to them, not to their companions, aides, or interpreters.

**Practice the Golden Rule:** Treat everyone as you would like to be treated. Think of the person first, not their disability.

**Always Ask Before Giving Assistance:** Just because a person has a disability, they don't necessarily need or want your assistance. Never help someone without first asking them.

**Think Before You Speak:** Avoid using labels when you speak - they are offensive to everyone, including people with disabilities.

**Avoid Showing Pity or Being Patronizing:** People with disabilities aren't victims.

When you interact with someone who uses a wheelchair, do not push, lean on, or hold the person's wheelchair. Try to put yourself at eye level when talking with someone in a wheelchair.



When you interact with someone who is visually impaired, always introduce yourself and let them know when you are leaving. You may offer your arm or elbow as a guide if they request assistance. Don't pet or distract a guide dog. The dog is responsible for its owner's safety and is always working - it is not a pet!!
