UNIFORM REMINDERS

Detailed information on the RedCoat uniform can be found on pages 13-14 of the Volunteer Handbook – but here are a few reminders:

The uniform includes:

Solid black dress slacks or skirt.

- If wearing a skirt, black tights or leggings must be worn.
- Not permitted: Jeans, anything with rivets or exposed zippers, cargo pants, leggings, athletic wear, leather material, capri pants, shorts, skorts.

Plain white shirt

Plain white shirt (long- or short-sleeve)
with a standard collar that buttons down
the front, tucked in (no lace, pearls,
ruffles, tone-on-tone, pleats, sports
shirts, polos, etc.).

Any jewelry worn should be small, simple and not detract from the uniform.
