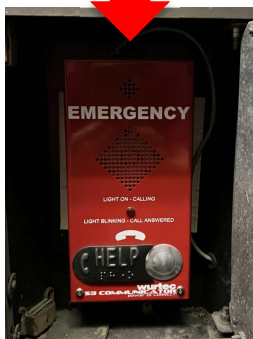

COHEN GARAGE ELEVATORS

There are over 34,000 elevators in the State of Ohio. Like any machine, they can malfunction. They can get stuck. They can get stuck with people inside. If you are stuck in the elevator, the most important thing is to stay calm and use the emergency communication system.



For the Cohen Garage, there are call buttons in both elevator cars that will ring directly to Schindler Elevator in case of entrapment.

As you can see in the pictures on the left, the emergency call button is located **behind** the elevator certificate of operation.

To access the emergency button – open the door by pulling on the “Phone” handle – indicated in the yellow circle. Press the button indicated to be connected to Schindler Elevator.

If you receive no response from Schindler in reasonable amount of time, call 9-1-1.

THEATER SWEEPS

An important part of the volunteer responsibility to our patrons is the post-performance sweep of the theaters. While we know most of the time these are handled correctly, we ALL need to make sure we are diligent.

Please be sure that each row is thoroughly checked – on the seats, between the seats, and under the seats. Before removing found items - accurately document their location – list the section, row, and seat number. Turn all found items into the house manager's office and list each item on the LOST ITEMS sheet. Thank you!
