DAZZLE AWARD ALUMS ON TOUR!

Dazzle Awards alumni Kyle McFalls and Julia Martini will return to Playhouse Square with the North American tour of The Who's *Tommy the Musical* when it opens here this fall!

Kyle, a graduate of The Akron School for the Arts at Firestone CLC, was our 2024 Dazzle Awards Best Actor. He will play the role of Cousin Kevin. Julia joins the company as a swing. She is a graduate of Archbishop Hoban High School.

One of our 2016 Dazzle Awards Best Actor nominees has been cast in the lead role of Oliver in the North American tour of *Maybe Happy Ending*, the role for which he has been the understudy on Broadway. Steven Huynh, graduate of Marion L. Steele High School and Baldwin Wallace University, will return to Cleveland with the show in March 2027.

SELTZER – BULKLEY – URN – OH MY!

The [photo in last week's newsletter](#) was from a display in the Bulkley Lobby next to the stairs going to Suite 200, set up by Archivist Ruth Flannery.

The "hole in the ground" is the site of the Bulkley before 1921. The building at the back is the C.A. Selzer Warehouse. Mr. Selzer sold the Blue Urn in the Palace to Edward Albee with an agreement that he could buy it back at a later date. As we all know...It's still here!
