# **TOUR ASSISTANTS**

The Volunteer Department is looking for additional RedCoats to accompany tour guides for private tours during the week. Private tours are offered throughout the week - primarily during the day.

Tour Assistants must be able to do all levels of the theater (including balconies).

## Responsibilities include:

- Holding doors open for guests.
- Following at the rear of the tour to make certain guests do not get left behind.
- If a quest is unable to follow part of the tour due to mobility issues, stay with the guest and engage in conversation.
- If there is an emergency while on the tour (guest or tour guide medical issue) - call security and/or leave the tour to get assistance from security.
- If a guest has a question that the tour guide does not hear, inform the tour guide of the guestion.
