- Able to remain for the entire performance

Responsibilities:

- Check in 15 minutes before regular volunteers for the pre-show HU briefing
- Follow designated policies and procedures as specified by the HM
- Be vigilant of potential safety issues
- Supervise pre-show and end of performance volunteer duties
- Team leader of RedCoats in assigned area
- Ensure all equipment is returned to designated areas

HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS FOR THE PLAYHOUSE SQUARE DISTRICT

WHILE WE ENJOY A VERY SAFE ENVIRONMENT, PLEASE REMEMBER THESE TIPS:

- Lock your possessions away from view at your desk, work space or in your car. PUT YOUR JUNK IN THE TRUNK!
- Pay close attention to your surroundings and stick to well-lit areas.
- Walk with a purpose; project an assertive businesslike image.
- Carry minimal items; overloading yourself can make you appear vulnerable.
- If you must carry valuables like important papers, jewelry and cash, choose to wear clothes with inside pockets.
- On Public Transit, be prepared: have the exact fare ready before you leave home or office so there is no need to open your purse or wallet.
- Always carry your keys in your hand so that you are ready to open the door.
- Avoid walking alone at night. As much as possible, walk or travel with a friend or co-worker, even during the daylight.
- Take advantage of the Downtown Cleveland Alliance Ambassador program.
 Request an escort via 216-621-6000. (Call thirty minutes prior to departure.)
- Please report any suspicious activity observed in the Playhouse Square District to Central Security Dispatch at 216-640-8777.
- If someone demands your property and displays or implies in any way that they have a weapon, don't resist. Hand your bag or wallet over to them.


