


The work on standardizing policies and procedures has begun!

ATTENTION: TICKET SCANNERS



If you are assigned to ticket scanning, please do not tell guests with digital ticket issues to come to box office to be issued "paper tickets".

Instead direct them to box office for assistance.

The box office staff is instructed to help guests figure out digital tickets, with printing only as a last resort.

NOTES ON THE SCHEDULE

Since making our comeback in 2021, we have added 1,000 new volunteers! We are now just over the number of volunteers we had pre-pandemic.

While this is certainly great news for Playhouse Square in that our volunteer ranks have come back to pre-2020 levels, it means that there are fewer performances in which to extra.

Our weekday evening, Saturday matinee and Sunday crews are now full. We are only recruiting new volunteers for Saturday evenings.

The Volunteer Department does its best to ensure that each team volunteers at least once every month. When the schedule indicates that extras are needed, only 10-20 volunteers are able to be added to the performance.

The schedule comes out every Wednesday morning at 6:00 am. If a request to extra comes in before 6:00 am, it is automatically processed last. Please wait until after the schedule is published to send in a request.

Check-back dates do work!

Most of our cancellations come in the two days before the performance.
