

#### Full Shows – Weekly Email

#### Full – Check back

For about a year we have been using "check back" dates on the schedule. This enables us to indicate to you when we have too many volunteers at a particular event. The "check back" date (two days prior to the event) is the day we will be filling in extras for anyone that has cancelled. If you want to be added to a Full event, emailing us early on that date is the best way to get in.

#### Coming as an Extra at a Full Event

Occasionally we have volunteers sign in at an event that is full. We are limited in the number of volunteers that we have at each event, which is why we ask you to verify on your schedule that the event is still taking volunteers before coming in as an extra.

#### New Designation and Email

Moving forward, we will be marking attendance with an X (as opposed to an A-Active, C-Cancel, or N-No Show) for anyone who came to a full show without permission from the Volunteer Office. Each week we will send out an email letting you know if you came to one of these shows.

#### I Received the Email, Now What?

- If you received this email in error please respond to the Volunteer Office and include an explanation of how you received confirmation to be on the show. (If you have the email handy, please forward that as well!
- If you accidentally came to a full show please respond to the email and just let us know. We understand that sometimes errors happen.
- If you continue to sign in to full shows after being told not to, disciplinary action may be taken.

We do our best to ensure that we take the most volunteers that we can at popular shows – but it's necessary to ensure we do not sacrifice the safety of guests, volunteers and staff in doing so. Thank you so much for your cooperation with this policy.

#### Coronavirus

We appreciate everyone taking extra precautions to stay healthy considering concerns about coronavirus, in addition to our usual yearly colds and flus.

In following <u>CDC guidelines</u>, we recommend increased hand washing for a minimum of 20 seconds. We are so appreciative of all you do, but want to remind you to consider your health first. Volunteers should stay home if they are sick or have a compromised immune system.

As the CDC does not recommend face masks as a preventative measure, we will not be adjusting uniform guidelines to allow for masks to be worn.

If you prefer to not handle guest's tickets, we have adjusted guidelines to allow RedCoats to ask guests to hold their own tickets and simply scan or look at them for the information rather than handling the tickets yourself.
