The Importance of Body Language

- Do you come across as bored or disinterested?
- Are you making eye contact with the people you are talking to?
- Are you coming across as friendly and welcoming?

Remember - it isn't just what you say - it's how you say it. Actors talk about the 5 P's:

- Projection can people hear you?
- Pace how fast are you talking?
- Pause do you pause for effect when talking about something important?
- Pitch how does your voice sound is it monotone, too high, too low?
- Power do your words have the right impact?


